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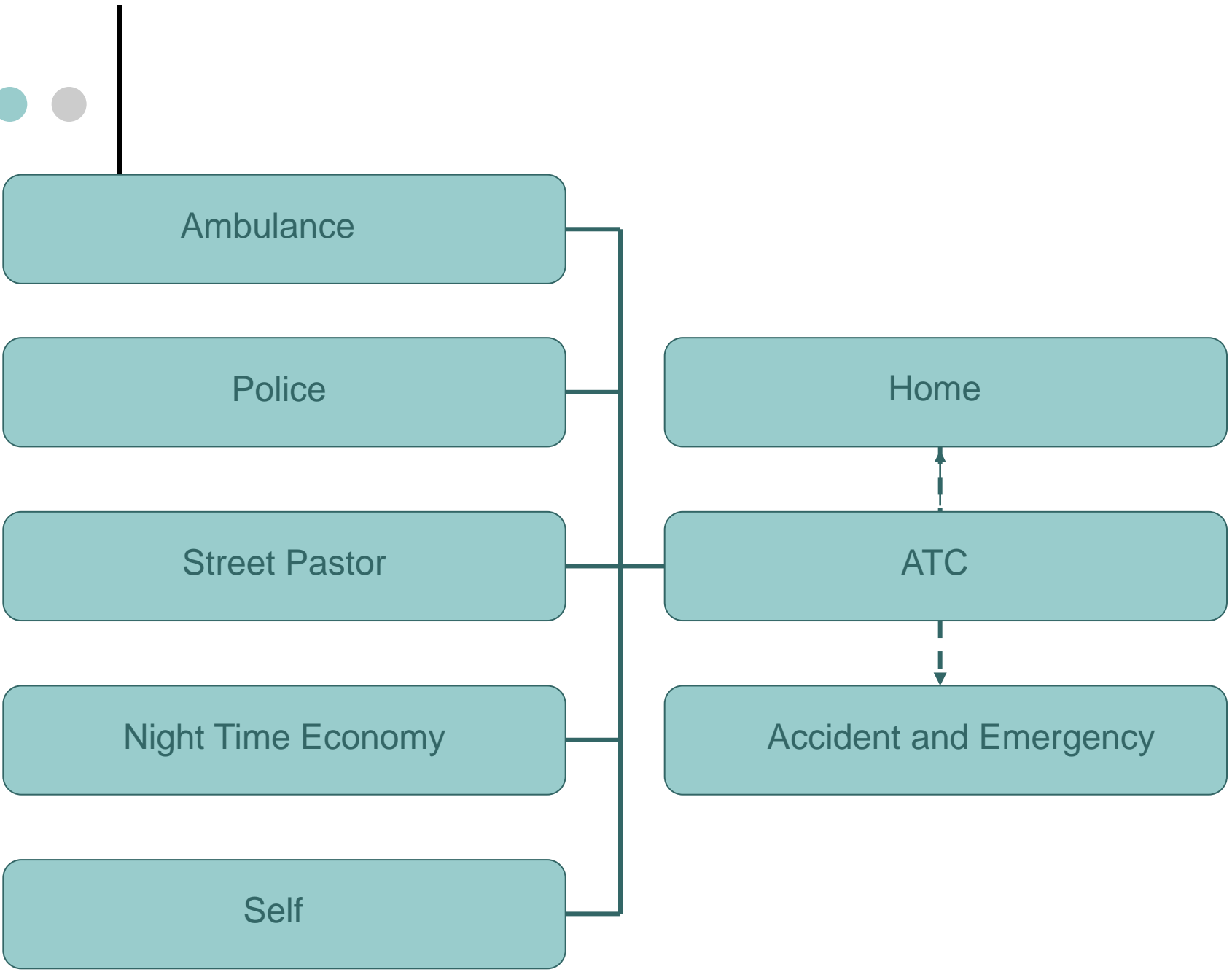

Achievements and Benefits

- Initial 3 month pilot led to 3 year SLA.
- March- Jan 2013-14 figures;
- 988 attendees
- 547 generated 999 WAST
- 219 SWP
- 61 self attendees
- 105 referred to UHW
