## Investigation into Welsh Government grants to private companies

I am writing in response to your request for information below dated 28 December 2020 in which you requested information regarding investigations into Welsh Government grants to private companies, by reference to a BBC article which referred to Kancoat Limited and KUKd Limited.

For ease of reference, I have reproduced your question below and set out our corresponding response.

I'm looking for the investigative report by the Wales Audit Office into how the Welsh Government give grants to private companies. If the report didn't come to fruition then I'd like to know what the reason was, including any email correspondence on the matter by Audit General Huw Vaughan Thomas.
